

With the start date of the Leaving Certificate State Examinations approaching, I would like to advise you on some matters which will assist 6th year at this time.

Firstly, please find the exam guidelines as set down by the Department of Education and Skills at www.examinations.ie

Please be aware of the following:

- Students must be in full school uniform for the duration of the exams. No non-school jackets/hoodies/bottoms will be permitted.
- Students are required to present on time for each exam. On Wednesday 9th June students must be at their exam centre at 9am. Students are designated to an exam centre based on their examination number for the duration of their exams. Information on exam centres has been shared with students on Teams. This information will also be posted in central locations in the school and students are advised to arrive early to access this information.
- For all other exams students have been instructed to arrive twenty minutes before the start time of each paper both in the morning and in the afternoon.
- Students will be refused entry into the examination centre if they arrive too late.
- Students are allocated their assigned centre by the DES. Therefore, it is necessary that all students know their examination number as this will be on their assigned desk.
- Students are instructed to use all the allocated time set for each paper to properly complete and check over their work. All students are advised not to leave the examination centre before the exam time has elapsed.
- Students are required to bring the necessary stationary needed to complete each exam as no sharing of equipment is permitted.
- As stated in our mobile phone policy, students are not allowed to use their phones while on the school campus. This applies during State Examinations also. Mobile phones cannot be brought into the examination centre.
- As student bags/school jackets etc., will remain outside the examination centre for the duration of the exam we advise that all valuables be left at home.
- Students will have the liberty of leaving school grounds between examinations. Teacher supervision of breaktimes is not available during the month of June. Should your son/daughter leave between the morning and afternoon exam can you please advise them on keeping safe and ensuring that they remain punctual for all exams. In line with

Covid 19 guidelines it is advised that students do not congregate large groups either within the school grounds our outside during the duration of the examinations.

- Social distancing of 2 metres will be implemented within each exam centre however students will still be required to wear masks at all times and to continue following the school hygiene protocols.


