## **Student Services Charge**

Scoil Dara continues the commitment to maintain a reasonable cost of the annual student services charge. This academic year, pupil first insurance will be included in our services charge, increasing the charge to €110. All payments relating to student services can be made through the Easy Payment Plus platform, accessed via the Scoil Dara website. The deadline for submission of the student services charge is Friday 15<sup>th</sup> August 2025. We appreciate the support of parents in the provision of the highest quality of education and student support for the next academic year.

### DES Free Book Scheme 2025-2026

The Department of Education Free Book Scheme provides free schoolbooks and core classroom resources thus eliminating the cost to parents to provide schoolbooks, copybooks and workbooks. As specified in the scheme guidance, schools must provide free schoolbooks and core classroom resources to all Junior Cycle students. **The scheme is now extended to Senior Cycle students for 2025-2026**. Core classroom resources include items like hardback notebooks, journals, calculators as well as subject-specific items like lab copybooks and dictionaries.

Schoolbooks remain the property of the school and are on loan to students. Parents will be notified in August with a date and time as to when schoolbooks and resources must be collected from the school in advance of return for the new academic year.
